

Consent with the Processing of Personal Data and the Sending of Commercial Communications

1) The customer agrees that CPI Národní, s.r.o., ID No.: 26211572, having its registered office at Vladislavova 1390/17, Nové Město, 110 00 Praha 1, registered in the Companies Register administrated by the Municipal Court in Prague under the file no. C 80090 (hereinafter referred to as the “*Operator/Administrator*”) will be processing the customers’ personal data provided in accordance with the valid legislation, particularly the Personal Data Protection Act No. 101/2000 Coll., as amended, in its database for sending commercial communications (hereinafter referred to as “*Newsletters*”) and will be doing so for an indefinite period of time for the Operator’s commercial and marketing purposes, i.e. particularly to maintain the database for sending Newsletters and offering business and services within the business activities of CPI Národní, s.r.o. in operation of the Quadrio commercial and shopping centre. The customer also acknowledges and agrees that the personal data provided by the customer for the aforementioned purpose and for the aforementioned period may be processed and stored through the Operator’s authorised employees or, as the case may be, through third parties (such as external contractual partners and processors of personal data) the up-to-date list of which is always published on the website of the Quadrio shopping centre at www.quadrio.cz.

2) The customer also hereby gives the Operator their express consent, within the meaning of the provision of Section 7 of Act No. 480/2004 Coll., on Certain Information Society Services, as amended, with the customer’s e-mail address being used to send commercial communications concerning the Operator’s business activity or concerning the tenants of the Quadrio shopping centre, i.e. the operators of individual retail stores and other businesses, particularly commercial communications containing information on the current special offer campaigns associated with the activities of the Quadrio shopping centre and on the current offers of the shopping centre’s tenants, the operators of individual retail stores and other businesses situated in the Quadrio shopping centre.

3) Provision of personal data by the customer is completely voluntary. The personal data will be processed in a hardcopy and electronic formats, particularly when they will be collected, copied for back-up, archived, used and subsequently liquidated. The customer notes that the customer is entitled to access the data provided by the customer and to correct, supplement and amend them; specifically, the customer is entitled to request the Operator to give information concerning the processing of the customer’s personal data pursuant to the provision of Section 12 of Personal Data Protection Act No. 101/2000 Coll., as amended, in the form of a written request addressed to the Operator. In that case, the Operator will be obliged to provide the customer with the requested information without undue delay. If the customer finds out that the Operator or a processor processes the personal data provided by the customer in a manner, which is in violation of the Personal Data Protection Act No. 101/2000 Coll. or in violation of the protection of personality rights, particularly if the personal data are inaccurate or incomplete with regard to the purpose of their processing, the customer may request the Operator or the processor to rectify such situation and can do so also in the form of a written request addressed to the Operator or directly to the current processor. In particular, this may involve blocking, correcting or amending the provided data, supplementing or liquidating the provided personal data. If the Operator or any other processor of personal data fails to grant such request, the customer will be entitled to contact directly the Office for Personal Data Protection with their request, and the procedure referred to in the previous sentence does not exclude the customer from contacting this office with

their request directly. The customer confirms that the customer was informed of their rights as an entity providing personal data within the meaning of the applicable provision of Section 21 of the Personal Data Protection Act No. 101/2000 Coll., as amended.

4) The customer explicitly agrees that the Operator or a third party authorised by the Operator is allowed to use the personal data provided by the customer for marketing and commercial purposes in connection with the sending of Newsletters. In particular, the customer agrees with the customer's name, surname and e-mail address being used pursuant to the provisions of Sections 77 through 90 of the Act No. 89/2012 Coll., the Civil Code, and thus hereby gives completely unconditional consent to the created data being used without any other further claims for the exclusive commercial and marketing purposes of the Operator and the Operator's external contractual partners and processors of personal data as well as the operators of the retail stores in the Quadrio shopping centre.

5) The customer confirms that the customer received the information to the effect that the customer can withdraw their consent with the processing of their personal data or with the sending of commercial communications at any time. The customer can carry out such withdrawal by giving a written notice addressed to the registered office of the Operator, which is CPI Národní, s.r.o., to the address Vladislavova 1390/17, Nové Město, 110 00 Praha 1 or by sending an e-mail message to the address info@quadrio.cz.
